Application Process	Students must be nominated by their home university and send the application documents to HTWD by Winter semester: June 15 th or Summer semester: November 15 th of the previous year.

	Students will receive a confirmation about the arrival of their application. The admission letter will be sent directly to the partner university or the student. An information email will be sent to all accepted students.
	The International Office will keep in touch with students via email prior to their arrival at HTWD.
Semester Fee	We do not charge study fees but we charge a semester fee of currently € 258.30 (summer semester 2016) which includes the ticket for public transport in the region of Dresden and Saxony, a fee for the Dresden Student Services and student's council. Students pay the fee before or upon their arrival in Germany (depending on their home country). Information will be sent to the students before they arrive in Dresden.
Module Selection	You should send us your Learning Agreement with your application. Therein you should decide which courses you want to study during your stay at the University of Applied Sciences Dresden. We mainly offer courses in German. The faculty Business Administration and the program Environmental Engineering offer courses in English.
