Application form:

The International Relations Office of the home university nominates students to Maria-Angélina BEAUCOURT and sends the application documents for her attention.

All nominated students have to submit the following documents (hard copy documents or PDF files):

- 2 Photos
- ID/Passport copy
- Copy of the official transcript of records
- Curriculum Vitae
- Letter (one page) introducing yourself and stating the reasons for applying to CPE Lyon (in French)
- European Health Insurance Card / Private health insurance
- Liability insurance

Semester dates:

Fall semester: September to end of January Spring Semester: February to end of June

Exchange students are requested to stay until the end of the scheduled exams. No special early exams can be arranged for them.

Attendance:

Attending to class is compulsory at CPE Lyon, including the French class.

CPE Lyon has its own accommodation for international students.

Residence Althea:

- The monthly rent for 2015-2016 is 410 €/month (with internet included).
- Rate for the academic year 2016-2017 will be confirmed in July.
- Deposit: 250 €
- Booking fees: 300 € for the full year or 150 € for one semester.
- Administration fees when you register: 10 €
- You must provide your own bedlinen, blankets or you can rent them and have them cleaned once a month for 10 € per month.
- Address: Résidence Althea 3 avenue Albert Einstein 69100 Villeurbanne
- Whatever the day you arrive, the full month is due.

Residence Einstein:

- It is a studio flat of around 18m2 in the Residence Einstein. It is a furnished flat, with a kitchenette (you must have your own kitchenwave) and a small shower/toilet bathroom.
- The monthly rent for 2015-2016 is 416 €/month (with internet included).
- Rate for the academic year 2016-2017 will be confirmed in July.
- Deposit: 250 €
- Booking fees: 300 € for the full year or 150 € for one semester.
- Administration fees when you register: 10 €
- You must provide your own bedlinen, blankets or you can rent them and have them cleaned once a month for 10 € per month.
- Address: Résidence Einstein 1bis/1ter avenue Albert Einstein 69100 Villeurbanne
- Whatever the day you arrive, the full month is due.

Visa Requirements:

All applicants from non EU nations must have a visa to study in France. In order to get a visa, all students must apply at the embassy or consulate of France in their home country at least 2 months prior to departure.

Health Insurance:

All incoming students at CPE Lyon need a health insurance.

For students from European Union:

Their European health insurance card has to be updated and the students must have it during all their stay at CPE Lyon.

<u>Students from non EU nations</u> will have to subscribe a health insurance with the school to the SMERRA or LMDE companies (= Sécurité Sociale Etudiante). The yearly cost in 2015-2016 is 215 € (cost to confirm for 2016-2017).

We also strongly recommend to the student to subscribe a complementary health insurance which supplements the student social security reimbursement (to almost 100%) with the SMERRA or LMDE companies.
